


On average, over 395 individuals a year are provided at no cost healthcare on a \$400,000 budget. All funding comes from the generosity of donors and foundations. We do not accept government funding.

Our clinic offers physical exams, laboratory evaluation, imaging, prescription assistance, eye exams, referrals to specialists, and post-hospital visit follow-up appointments.

In 2024...

We had 3,373 office visits and 286 provider visits
12 physicians volunteered their services
HSC had 132 optometry visits
126 pairs of eye glasses were distributed
